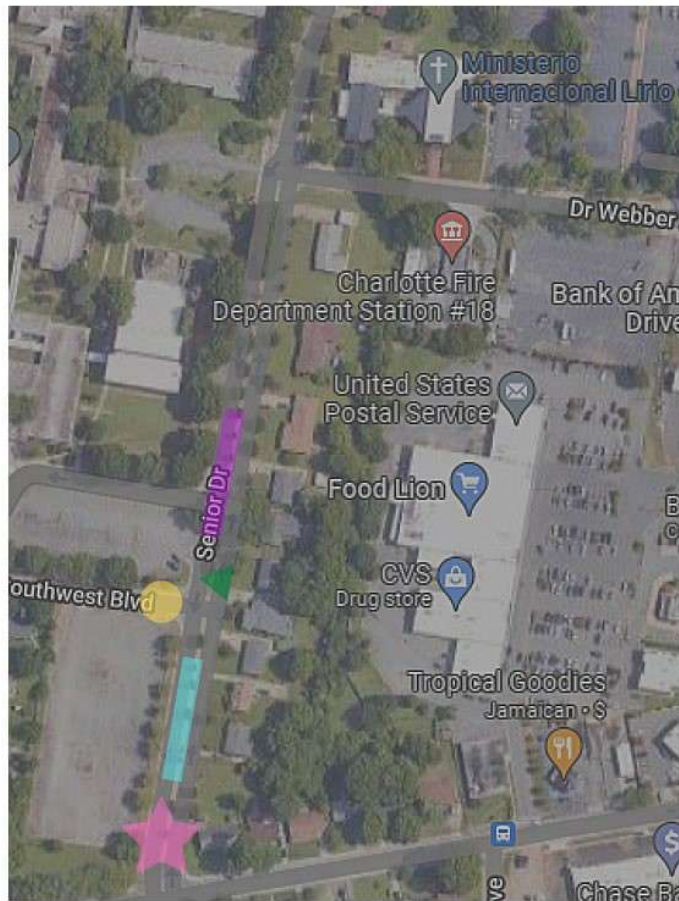
Dear Juneteenth Vendor:

On behalf of For The Struggle, Inc. and The Gantt, thank you for your participation in the 2026 Juneteenth Celebration. We are excited to have you celebrate black liberation and freedom on Charlotte’s historically black corridor. Below are details regarding the event.

Location and Site Map:

This celebration will occur on Senior Drive, in front of West Charlotte High School.

Arrival and Set-Up:

Please arrive for set up between 10:00 and 12:00 noon.

If you arrive after 12:00 noon, you will not be permitted to set up or participate. To drop off vending items, you may enter at the corner of LaSalle and Senior Drive or at the corner of Dr. Weber and Senior Drive. You are allowed 15 minutes to pull in and drop off items. Thereafter, you must park your vehicle elsewhere. There is a parking lot on the corner of Senior and Southwest where you are permitted to park.

Upon arrival, you will register at the vendor registration table located at the corner of Southwest Blvd and Senior Drive. There will be two chairs available for each vendor. However, **you must bring your own table and tent for shade.** For The Struggle will not have extra tents and tables available this year. Volunteers will be present to assist you with unloading your items into your designated vendor location should you need assistance.

Registration and Payment:

All non food vendors are required to complete the vendor registration form and make payment **no later than noon on Friday, June 12, 2026.**

Please see <https://form.jotform.com/251187273307154> to do so. All food vendors MUST have a permit as required by the County of Mecklenburg to serve food. By participating you agree that, if you are a vendor selling food items, you have obtained proper permits. Your participation is an agreement that you will defend, indemnify and/or reimburse For The Struggle for any and all issues that may arise from your sale of food and/or permit requirements.

- Your time of arrival for set up;
- Whether you need volunteer assistance to transport items from your vehicle to your designated vending location; and
- Confirmation that your vendor registration and payment has been submitted. If you are a food vendor, confirmation that you have necessary permit to participate.
